To our valued supporters

In an effort to continue to communicate in an open and effective manner with you, our valued supporters, partners, and friends, The Board of Directors of Child Find Alberta would like to make you aware of a situation involving the former publisher of our newsmagazine, Cedar Publishing and its current relationship with Child Find.

In 2007 Child Find and Cedar Publishing entered into an arrangement that saw Cedar Publishing Corporation produce a newsmagazine on behalf of Child Find. This magazine allowed Child Find to continue to educate the public in areas of children's issues and bring the public's attention to the issue of missing, exploited and abducted children.

Unfortunately, effective April 30, 2009, Child Find Alberta has provided Cedar Publishing with a notice of termination, and, as far as Child Find is concerned, Child Find has ended its relationship with Cedar Publishing. While we are regretful of the notice of termination, it is our view that it is in the best interests of Child Find and those that they assist and support that Child Find severs this relationship. Child Find has advised Cedar Publishing that it has no further authority to use the Child Find name and trade-mark.

Accordingly, it is the position of Child Find, commencing May 1, 2009, that any solicitations by Cedar Publishing are without any authority from Child Find, are not in support of Child Find, and are not supported by Child Find. Cedar Publishing may not accept our position that the relationship of Child Find with Cedar has been terminated and may continue to act as though the relationship continues. However, Child Find will no longer accept any support from Cedar Publishing and specifically will not accept or receive funds from Cedar Publishing.

[Should Cedar Publishing continue to act without the authority of Child Find, Child Find has sought legal counsel, and Child Find is considering commencing litigation to enforce its rights. Child Find hopes that litigation is not necessary, and would prefer not to incur any legal costs, but Child Find may find it has no choice but to pursue legal action. Child Find will announce any litigation it or Cedar Publishing may commence.

Child Find is the leader in child education, protection, and re-location services in Canada. For over 25 years we have strived to ensure that the children of Alberta, and Canada are safe from harm, and will continue to work to meet that mandate head-on while living the values of transparency, accountability and responsibility to those that support our mission, and assist us
